Course description:

A man who has committed a mistake and does not correct it, is committing another mistake – Confucius.

This course is about searching better ways for a smart decision. It focuses on how our thoughts are influenced, why we make misjudgments and tools to improve our thinking for smart decisionmaking. If we understand what influences us, we might avoid certain traps and understand why others act like they do. And if we learn and understand what works and does not work and find some framework for reasoning, we will make better judgments and smart decisionmaking. We cannot eliminate mistakes, but we can prevent those that can really hurt us. In the end, it will help you make smarter choices, both in your private and your professional life.
